### ICEBREAKER:

Who are your favorite heroes (historical, fictional, or both)? Why?

### BIG IDEA:

Today's big idea: As followers of Jesus, we put others over ourselves by serving in our church, our city, and around the world.

**SCRIPTURE:** Luke 10:25-37

### DISCUSSION:

1. Under what circumstances would you be willing to “love your neighbor” like the Samaritan man did? When have you done so?
2. How does Jesus respond to the lawyer’s question, “Who is my neighbor”? What is Jesus’ answer?
3. Jesus says that we have been created and called to love those in need, whether in our neighborhoods, in faraway places in the world, or even within the next generation here at Community. Which of these is the most comfortable for you to serve? Why? Which of these is the most challenging or uncomfortable for you? Why?

### LIFE APPLICATION:

1. When have you considered going on a mission trip? Where would you go? What would you like to do there?
2. Where have you served here at church? Have you considered serving children or students? What makes you excited and/or anxious about serving the next generation?
3. Who is your neighbor? When have you passed by someone in need? How does that feel? What is God calling you to do next?
