#### ICEBREAKER:

**SCRIPTURE:** 1 Corinthians 2:10-16

#### DISCUSSION:

1. What stood out to you from Pastor Brad's message? Was there a challenging thought or encouraging moment for you?
2. Can you share a time when you were pretty clear what God was directing you to do?
3. Have someone read 1 Corinthians 2:10-16. What is the role of the Spirit in our ability to hear and respond to the gospel?
4. Do you know of an example where someone couldn't hear God speak because their own habits or actions were drowning out what God might have been clearly saying to them?

#### LIFE APPLICATION:

1. What have been the best resources for you to discern God's intention for you life?
2. What spiritual disciplines (prayer, Bible study, meditation on Scripture, etc.) could you practice this week to make you sensitive to the Holy Spirit?
3. What does it mean to have the mind of Christ? How can you know if you have the mind of Christ?

#### Take Time:

To feel "boxed in" is to be human; we will all experience this from time to time for a myriad of reasons. Jesus would not have us trapped there. Looking back at the series **Boxed In** as a whole, in what ways are you feeling led to break out of the box? Is there something you have been wrestling with or discovering about your relationship with Jesus? What is the next step you are taking?
