Grace

ICEBREAKER:

Share a time when you were given something (a gift, opportunity, or experience) you absolutely did not deserve. How did that make you feel toward the person who gave it to you?

> Was there a particular passage that stood out to you?

SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 2:1-10

DISCUSSION:

1. Share what stood out to you from Pastor Brad's message. Was there a specific thought or story that sparked inspiration, or a difficult observation that you had to wrestle with?
2. Have someone read Ephesians 2:1-10. What stands out to you from this passage? It could be a verse or principle that you've not noticed before, or some description about God and His grace.
3. What according to Paul characterizes people who are heading in the wrong direction (v.1-3)? What remedy does verses 4-6 give for people being dead in sin?
4. Ephesians 2:8-10 paints a powerful picture of God's desire to rescue. What is the means of our salvation?

LIFE APPLICATION:

1. Can you give an example of a person who felt they had to earn love in a relationship (parent/child, husband/wife, etc.)? What dangers arise in this kind of relationship?
2. Is there an area of your life that you are not showing God the loyalty that reflects his grace to you? What step could you take to align with God's grace in that area?
3. But by grace...as we close out the EPIC series, what has or will change in your relationship with God? What has or will change as you play a part in God's EPIC story?

Take Time:

You were created in Jesus for good works! Have you been able to gain or discover what those good works are? If so, what is something you feel like God is leading you toward? If not, is there someone you can reach out to that can help you get a sense of where God might be leading you? Take time to pray for one another in your group to live a grace-filled life.
